Prepare your home for the cold weather



Keep the heat in and the cold out – make sure your home is well insulated and check for draughts around doors and windows



Using low energy lighting inside and outside costs 90% less than standard lightbulbs, which is very important with the shorter days



Heat your living spaces to at least 18 degrees and try and keep an even temperature throughout your home



Program your heating to switch on half an hour before you need it and off half an hour before bed



Check your boiler is working properly now, before the temperature drops and you really need it
